

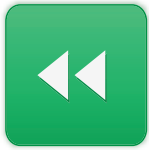

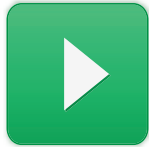
Click the Recite button on the website to bring up the Recite Toolbar

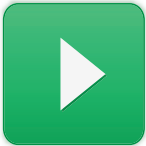

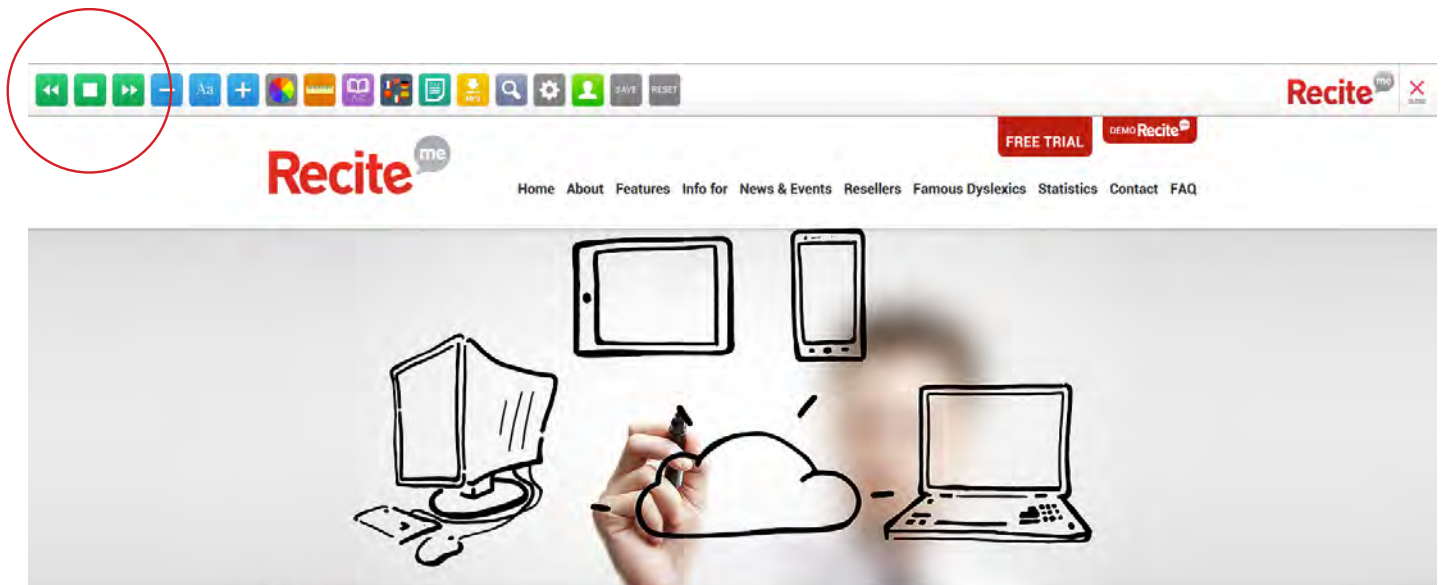
